

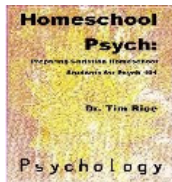

## Homeschool Psych: Preparing Christian Homeschool Students for Psych 101



### *Homeschool Psych: Preparing Christian Homeschool Students for Psych 101*

Psychology is a controversial and sometimes frightening subject which often challenges or even contradicts a Christian worldview. When our homeschooled high schoolers start looking at college classes, Psychology 101 is on most lists of basic requirements. We have textbooks that teach the natural sciences like Physics and Chemistry from a Christian worldview, and now Dr. Tim Rice has provided a text that does the same for Psychology. In this soft-cover book, Dr. Rice offers an introduction to Psychology that any Christian parent would be glad to teach. He compares and contrasts biblical teachings with psychology lessons, allowing the student to understand the history and principles of the subject without abandoning Christianity.

After introducing the student to psychology and its relationship to Christian worldviews, both past and present, Dr. Rice continues by teaching a basic introduction to psychology. Lessons include abnormal psychology, learning, personality, the development of Modern Psychology, and an overview of many famous names in psychology, treatments, and the biology of the brain and senses. Nevertheless, the biblical perspective is consistent throughout. The text (available from www.homeschoolpsych.com for \$29.95) offers well-organized lessons, as well as assignments, quizzes, vocabulary, and additional study options. The student workbook, which sells for \$14.95, has room for writing definitions and assignments, quizzes (fill in the blank) and answers to homework and quizzes. This textbook is a welcome answer to the parent who is struggling to determine how to prepare kids for one of the most secular subjects in the early years of their student's college career.
